Description

Purpose

MWA seeks an experienced Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) Lead for the anticipated USAID Sustainable, Transformational and Accessible WASH Interventions (STAWI) under the Addendum to Diversifying Partnerships in WASH (DiP-WASH) Program in Kenya.

STAWI's objectives are to Improve governance of water resources and services; Increase the sustainability of water service delivery; Improve management, efficiency, and equitable access to water used for productive purposes; and Improve collaboration and learning across stakeholders under the leadership and coordination.

Job Summary

MWA is the prime implementing agency in a consortium of local partners that will be working in nine Arid and Semi-Arid counties of Kenya. The MEL Lead will report to the Chief of Party and will provide technical oversight on the program's activities that are geared towards improving management, efficiency, and equitable access to water for productive purposes. The MEL Lead will work in a dynamic team at the Program Hub and at the implementing partners' level. The position holder will also maintain close working relations with the STAWI Contract to achieve the broader Collaboration, Learning and Adaptation (CLA) agenda.

Responsibilities

The MEL Lead will provide technical oversight in the planning, decision making and implementation of the following functions:

- Line manages the MEL/Communication Officer.
- Set up and manage the program's MEL system while ensuring that there is adequate technical capacity among the staff to enhance the performance of the system.
- Closely work with the MWA and partner staff to review the MEL framework and theory of change with a view to developing an annual performance management plan (PMP) with clear targets per implementing partner per year.
- Develop and adopt Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) tools for measuring and reporting on indicators performance; develop indicator guidance reference sheet for activity output and outcome indicators.
- Lead the monitoring of the program's performance indicators and offer timely advice on areas that need remedial measures.
