This job is found in WFP Ethiopia Country Office, Dessie SO. Job holder reports to Dessie SO Programme Head under the general guidance of Head of SO. She/he will work closely with Bahir Dar Area Office and CO nutrition and school feeding technical staffs for the day-to-day operational matters. At this level, the job holder demonstrates responsibility and initiative to respond independently to queries with the general guidance of the Head of programmes. There is a requirement to use judgment in dealing with unforeseen problems on a daily basis. The job holder typically is responsible to manage and effective implementation of all activity two, four and six components in areas under the responsibility of Dessie SO.

Responsibilities

Under the general supervision of Dessie SO head of programs and technical support by Bahir Dar Area Office and CO technical staffs, the program assistant will be responsible for the following activities:

- Serve as a focal point for WFP Dessie SO for all initiatives under Activity two, four and six in the Eastern part of Amhara region;
- Liaise with government counterparts, CPs, FSPs, and other stakeholders on all technical aspects related to Activity two, four and six;
- Coordinate on-ground implementation of Activity two, four and six in the Eastern part of Amhara region;
- Support capacity strengthening activities at regional and local level falling under nutrition and school feeding interventions;
- Coordinates the establishment of various local partnership forums to facilitate learning and scaling up of good practices relevant to WFP;
- Maintain up to date information and provide timely information as required;
